UNION COUNTY ELEVATED TO LEVEL 3 ALERT FACEMASKS REQUIRED WHILE IN THE URE LOBBY

Late last week, Governor DeWine announced the Public Health Alert Level for Union County was elevated to a Level 3 (Red) Alert as a result of a sustained increase in cases and outpatient visits over the past week.

From our perspective, the safety of our employees and consumer-members are paramount.

FACIAL COVERING MANDATE:

People in counties under a Level 3 (red) or Level 4 (purple) public health alert are required, based on an Ohio Department of Health order, to wear facial coverings that cover the nose, mouth, and chin when they are out.

When required, face coverings must be worn:

- o In any indoor location that is not a residence.
- o Outdoors, if it is not possible to consistently maintaining a distance of at least six feet between people who are not members of the same household.
- o When waiting for, riding, driving, or operating public transportation, a taxi, a private car service, or a ride sharing vehicle. (This does not apply to private or rental vehicles in which members of a single family are sharing a vehicle or to vehicles travelling through a listed county without stopping in that county.)
