



Information needed to complete any easement for URE electric or gas service.

1. Official names on the deed.
2. The recorded instrument number from the Grantors Deed.
3. The parcel number where the easement will reside. (Not the parent parcel)
4. The number of acres of the parcel. (Not the parent parcel)
5. The written legal description of the parcel. (Not the parent parcel)
 - a. Virginia Military Survey number (VMS)
 - b. County the parcel resides in
 - c. Township the parcel resides in

Much of the above information will be on the Grantor's Deed. Please be certain that you turn in this information so that we can prepare the electric utility easement. No construction can be completed on the property without a signed easement.

Your County Agency, most likely the Auditor's Office or Recorder's Office should be able to help you obtain any missing information.
